# SPIRITUAL GROWTH AND DISCIPLESHIP:

- TAG (Time Alone with God) will be a daily discipline, and TAG debriefs will happen frequently.
- Small Group: Interns will meet regularly with full time staff to check in on each other's spiritual and emotional health and to discuss scripture and other spiritual books we are reading together.
- Mentorship: Each intern will be assigned a mentor who checks in on them regularly.

## PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT:

- Interns will gain many practical skills from daily work at camp.
- Interns will engage in training concerning budgeting, resume building, interview skills, and other areas of interest.
- Interns will interact with guest speakers from business and ministry settings who will share insight on using their work as a platform for the gospel.

### **ACADEMIC GROWTH:**

(Not required, but encouraged)

- Interns may be enrolled as a part-time or full-time student at an online university program. If enrolled, ample study time will be built into the schedule each week.
- Interns may count their CH internship for university credit hours. \*This must be something interns set up with their individual university. CH's internship director will assist interns in getting approval from their university.

#### TRAVEL:

- Interns will visit many of our ministry partners such as churches, schools, nonprofit organizations, and business leaders to experience firsthand how God is moving in the world outside of camp.
- Interns will participate in outdoor adventures designed to challenge them physically, mentally, and spiritually.

#### **PAY & TIME OFF:**

- Interns will receive room and board along with a per week stipend paid biweekly.
- Interns will have at least 36 hours of off time (usually Sunday evenings and Mondays) each week.
- Additional off days may be requested in advance by submission to the internship director.
